About Write by the Sea

Write By The Sea is a literary festival set in the intimate fishing village of Kilmore Quay, Co Wexford. It offers a platform for established and emerging authors to explore and explain the process of writing for keen readers and aspiring writers.

The programme for *Write By The Sea* includes a generous mix of talks, readings, interviews and workshops. Overlooking the picturesque Saltee Islands, the inspirational setting of Kilmore Quay is also an appropriate location in which to celebrate the international achievements of Irish authors and to encourage new writing across all genres.

Our first annual festival was held in 2016. 2020 should have been our fifth festival but was cancelled due to Covid-19. At this point all of our 2020 writers have agreed to participate in 2021 (Government Regulations permitting) and the festival is scheduled to take place from 24-26 September.

The festival is supplemented by Zoom Room to Write events (Masterclasses, Workshops, talks by writers and interviews with writers). These events will take place on the second Saturday of the month, starting in March 2021.

- The volunteer will not divulge any confidential WBTS information to any third party.
- The volunteer will ensure that the content of blogs or posts and any images used in blogs or posts do not contravene copyright regulations.
- Images and copy provided by Write by the Sea may only be used for the purpose for which they are provided.
- Write by the Sea reserves the right, following due consultation, to amend or decline submitted posts.
- To ensure that the volunteer's time is respected, the nature and frequency of the
 articles and posts required will be determined by mutual agreement and Write by the
 Sea will ensure that adequate notice and clear briefing is provided.
